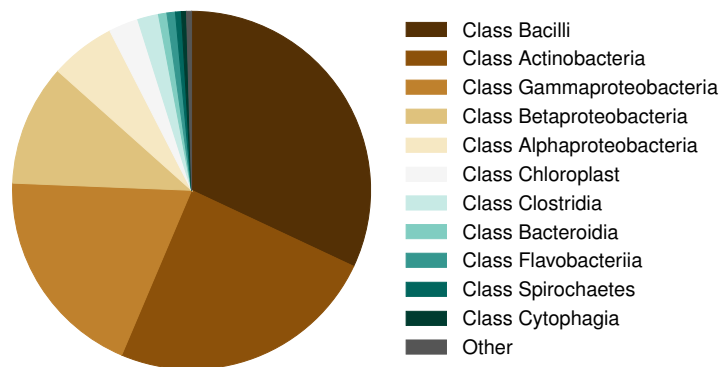

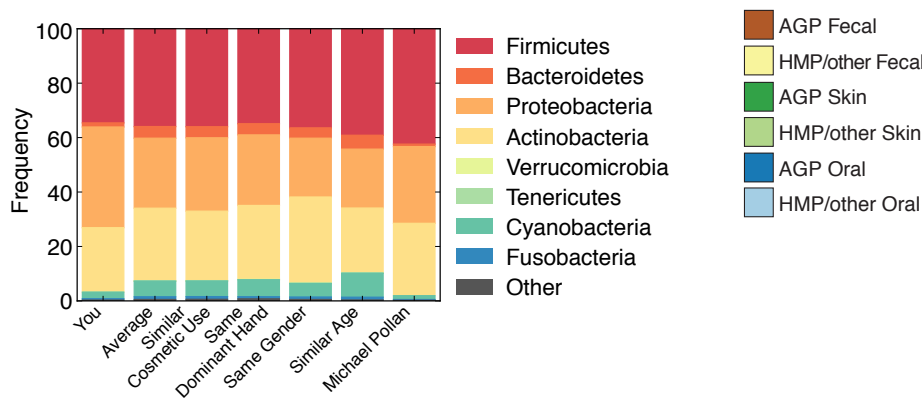

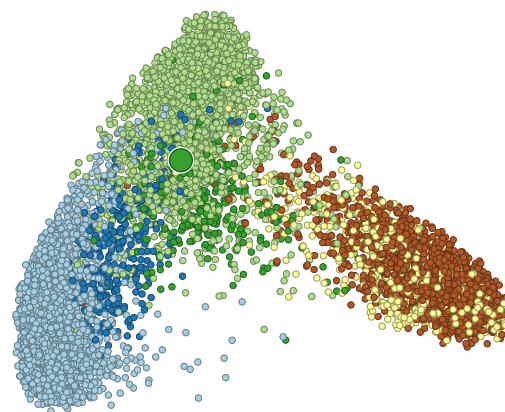

How do your skin microbes compare to others?

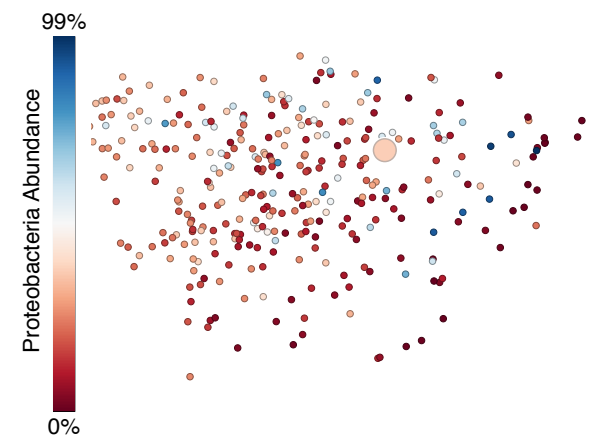
